TIPS WHEN PLANNING A TEAM BUILDING EVENT

- An understanding and appreciation of the **values, needs, abilities** and **challenges** of the team is a starting point in planning a team building event.
- Prior to booking a team building exercise, canvas the **views and ideas** of the members of the group, what have they done before, any particular interests or requirements?
- Take into account the **age, culture** and **relative physical ability** of the group. Match this to the relative activity of the teambuilding product. Most of Beach and Bush's team builds are low impact and suitable for almost all groups.
- Discuss the **desired goal** of the team build with your consultant. Certain team builds are targeted at addressing specific group dynamic challenges within a group.
- Attaining **buy-in** from the group members prior to arrival is always a good idea. This can be done by way of email teasers or cryptic invitations, ask your consultant for advice.
- **Choice of Venue** is an important factor. The tone of the team build should be matched to the venue chosen. A choice between rustic or luxury is important in relation to the team building to be carried out. In addition travelling time is an important factor.
- **Timing** of the team building needs to be taken into account. Try to mix physical outdoor team building activities with more relaxing social team building activities.



TEAMBUILDING PRODUCTS

ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

(1) Indiana Jones Team Build



This portable, on-site adventure event has been designed and themed around the exciting Indiana Jones Movie series. Teams learn to improve co-ordination, planning, communication and trust through a fun but challenging range of activities combined in a low impact competitive format.

The idea is for groups to compete in a number of unique exciting events in order to collect artifacts which are used to construct a fictional warrior.

Being portable, the event can be set up almost anywhere.

This event is customizable and can be run at almost any outdoor venue. Challenges during the event include:

- Ultimate djembe drum war-cry challenge
- Spear throwing and paintball shooting challenges
- Bridge, raft or tower construction
- Blindfold croquet or high speed radio control car racing
- Garmin GPS orienteering challenge
- Art challenge
- Giant puzzles

A full safety briefing is given prior to the start and our experienced facilitators ensure that the event is inclusive and that everybody enjoys and participates at a level they are comfortable with.

(2) CSI Challenge Team Build



The CSI Challenge is one of Beach & Bush's most popular team builds. Based on the TV series of the same name, the CSI Challenge will have you working together in small teams while utilising lateral thinking and common sense to piece together a homicide.

The CSI challenge is divided into sections, and the teams must move through each stage of the overall investigation, completing relevant tasks:

- crime scene investigation
- interrogation room
- ballistics range
- evidence processing
- identikit.

Although this team build is not structured as a race, time allocations are given for each section to encourage quick thinking and successful planning in approaching each task.

A Beach & Bush facilitator mans each stage group dynamics are analyzed as each group progresses. Teams piece together the evidence to build a case and justify an arrest warrant proving means, motive and opportunity.

Groups are judged according to their skill in successfully completing each of the tasks allocated.

(3) uShaka Challenge Team Build



The uShaka Challenge team build is an on-site adventure challenge which is a cross between the "Amazing Race" and "Fear Factor" Team Build" held at uShaka Marine World, Durban. Get wet, meet a pirate, build a raft, test your artistic talents and attempt to attain the title of "uShaka Challenge Champions".

The uShaka Challenge is one of Beach & Bush's most established team builds and has been successfully run with groups as diverse as Unilever, BMW, MTN, Vodacom, Thompson Tours, Standard Bank, Nedbank, Old Mutual, Momentum Life, ABSA, Liberty Life, SAB, Tiger Brands and many other corporate and government groups.

General

The appeal is that the uShaka Challenge team build is low impact and the focus is on fun while, the challenges are specifically structured to encourage fundamental team building outcomes such as, improved communication, cohesion and respect for roles and norms.

Activity Options: you can choose to either do a 'dry' or 'wet' uShaka Challenge Team Build.

WET (following 3 + choice of 5 Dry):

Lazy River Catch Up Race: find a clue in the river running through the park

Snorkel Lagoon Treasure Hunt: find a clue hidden in the lagoon

Chicken Run Plunge: go down a 90 degree slide holding an egg without breaking it

DRY (all 8):

Wimpy Challenge: have to make something and eat it.

Activity Course: Spiders Web, tube race, team ski, magic carpet

Art challenge: Complete a cultural painting to the satisfaction of the judges

Polaroid Camera Aquarium challenge: find a clue situated in the aquarium, take a Polaroid picture as proof of finding it to get the next clue

Aquarium Quiz: Find the hidden clues in the aquarium

Canal Kayaking Challenge: Low impact Kayaking in the uSaka Canals, learn to paddle a kayak and complete the defined course

Ultimate War-cry Challenge: Use the Vuvuzelas, Ghanaian Djembe Drums and other items to put together the ultimate team war-cry

Giant Puzzles: Ocean-themed giant puzzles are a challenge for even the most focused team, complete these and you're done!

(4) Beach Olympics Team Build



Durban, playground of the Zulu kingdom, is renowned for its sun, surf and beaches. Beach and Bush's Beach Olympics team build combines an exciting morning/afternoon of low impact activities with a fun day on the beach. Why not treat your staff and give them a day out of the office with a difference

Beach and Bush's Beach Olympics team build is suitable for groups of 16 - 300 plus. Participants are placed in teams of +/- 6 and compete against each other on a round robin basis. Beach Olympics activities include:

- Volleyball
- Soccer
- Frisbie Golf
- Limbo Dancing
- Tug-Of-War
- Cricket

Teams are scored according to a win, lose or draw system and the team with the highest score WINS!

Although physical, the events do not require any serious level of fitness.

Each round robin takes 30 minutes; 20 minutes for the event and a 10 minute break to catch your breath and put your feet up. Beach & Bush will set up Gazebos on the beach for your team build.

(5) Movie Making Team Build



This is a fun, highly interactive programme where every single person can get involved, regardless of their age, level of fitness or physical abilities.

Each team works together to write a script, produce, direct and act in the "Movie" using limited resources. Teams are given a "Movie Making Kit" which contains an assortment of materials, props and goodies. Everyone has to tap into both their creative and practical abilities as they start to produce their movie.

Movie Making provides excellent value for money because not only does it provide an afternoon of teambuilding but great entertainment when the teams get to view the movies. Awards can be arranged and given with due ceremony for the various categories, often recognising and celebrating some hidden talents.

Movie Making can be easily adapted to meet your various requirements and options include producing a "mini movie" with a given title, an advertisement for an existing or future product, a news broadcast or a weather forecast.

(6) Art Challenge Team Build



The idea is to challenge a teambuilding group creatively and ascertain whether they can effectively communicate and co-ordinate in order to create a large scale picture from smaller parts.

A basic acrylic painting course is presented before the start of the activity. Planning is essential and teams will need to discuss and delegate the various aspects of the activity. Delegates must work effectively both within groups and between groups in order to accomplish the tasks at hand.

Groups are challenged creatively and are free to interpret the piece of art as they see fit. At the end of the exercise the teams have the option of having the piece of art framed and it can then be mounted in the offices of the company. Can be held outdoors or indoors at most venues.

A great option for a teambuilding group or leisure group looking for a fun, low impact activity that can be done indoors.

(7) Activity Course Team Build

(8) Masterchef Potjie Challenge Team Build



A great cross-cultural South African tradition. A powerful team development experience as groups compete to prepare the ultimate potjie meal. A brilliant way to spice up a corporate event or breakaway or for leisure groups looking for an exciting ice-breaker.

The Potjie Challenge can be incorporated into most itineraries and is an excellent way to combine team building with a meal. Most resorts are happy to integrate a planned evening or lunch meal with this challenge

The format of the event is as follows:

- Team build group is divided into teams.
- Potjie pots, fires, ingredients are provided.
- Full briefing is given regarding the rules to be followed.
- The extensive range of ingredients, sauces, herbs etc provides teams with the freedom to prepare the potjie to their specification.
- Teams are required to explain up front what their potjies will taste like on completion.

- Judging follows strict culinary guidelines, contestants are judged according to taste, presentation and consistency.

On the completion of judging the potjies are laid out and the delegates may choose which Potjie to eat.

(9) Amazing Race Team Build



Beach and Bush's fantastic team build, based on the TV show, The Amazing Race. This adventure race is an off-site team-based race where teams are allocated a car, decide on a driver and race each other to complete a series of events. First team home...WINS!!

The amazing race is customised to the area in question. Beach and Bush have set up routes throughout South Africa, but are always willing to re-quote and re-plan according to your needs.

The tone of Beach and Bush's Amazing Race team build is sophisticated, yet fun. Events are chosen based on your desired team building outcome. Challenges such as the 'art challenge' are geared to set a more sophisticated tone, and events such as the 'road block' and 'giant puzzles' test your skills whilst keeping the event light hearted and fun.

Brief overview: Teams meet at the start of the race. They are given instructions on the route and details of the challenges, which can be completed in any order. Teams begin the race, completing ALL the challenges as quickly as possible, acquiring clues after each challenge allowing them to proceed. The objective is simple....complete all the challenges and be the first team home.

(10) Garmin GPS Cocktail Treasure Hunt



Beach and Bush's Cocktail Treasure Hunt team build is a fantastic alternate to physical team building. Participants spend time in groups completing low-impact / mentally challenging orienteering tasks in set time limit and end off by creating unique cocktails, to be sampled and judged by the facilitators, and enjoyed by the participants.

Beach and Bush's Cocktail Treasure Hunt team build is a superb way to end a heavy day of conferencing or a great way to supplement a day of physically taxing team building.

HOW IT ALL WORKS: Complete a question sheet. Each correctly answered question allows you a choice from the COCKTAIL SHOP.

Participants are divided into teams and have a time limit in which to find as many answers as possible. Some questions are straight forward, where as others are slightly more cryptic and will require some lateral thinking.

Questions are divided into sections - ALCOHOL / JUICES / DECORATIONS / EXTRAS - and the more questions you get right, the more choices you have for ingredients for your cocktail. The trick is to try and answer a couple of questions from each section to ensure a decent variety of choice. Your team may be stuck if they find themselves with 3 alcohols and some sugar and mint and nothing to use as mix????....or maybe that's your plan :)

After you've shopped at the Cocktail Shop, teams work together to create and name their own cocktails. Each member gets to make and drink their own cocktail, but teams decide together which ingredients to "buy".

Even if participants would like to make a non-alcoholic cocktail, there is enough choice to do so.

At the end each group must present their cocktails and explain them, they are judged and the cocktail champions are announced.
